

Leelanau Press History Article Honoraria Application



A history article honoraria is offered to encourage research and writing on a historic Leelanau County subject. These articles will be suitable for publication on the LHS website or newsletter, and/or local journals, or newspapers. The award is \$250. This honoraria is made possible by the Leelanau Press.

Interested researchers and writers should submit a letter of interest in the honoraria and address the following:

1. A brief description of the title and subject.
2. Your interest/curiosity in the subject matter.
3. Your background and previous research and writing experience.
4. The sources and resources you expect to consult and utilize.

Letters are accepted on a rolling basis as funding allows. Applicants will be notified within four weeks of submission. Recipients will work with the Leelanau Historical Society staff to determine a timeline and appropriate publication format. The article should generally be 600-1200 words and include cited sources as well as related images or documents.

The Leelanau Historical Society reserves the right to invite qualified writers or researchers to compose an article and receive the honoraria, without requiring a letter of interest. Leelanau Historical Society staff and trustees are not eligible for the honoraria.
